

Workshops and Seminars at School Level

Hooghly (Tarakeswar & Pursurah Blocks): Engaged students and teachers through orientation programs, introducing career mapping tools and scholarship opportunities.



South 24 Parganas (Diamond Harbour): Initiated our program in semi-urban and rural schools, focusing on bridging the knowledge gap for students from marginalized backgrounds.



Programme Highlights

Students were introduced to career courses in fields such as healthcare, technology, humanities, business, and skilled trades.

Interactive sessions helped students align their personal interests with academic and career choices.

Teachers and parents were also sensitized, recognizing their crucial role in guiding and supporting children's aspirations.
